Confessional Lutheran post-graduate studies in Gothenburg

Lutheran School of Theology (Församlingsfakulteten) in collaboration with Concordia Theological Seminary

In January 2014, the *Lutheran School of Theology* in Gothenburg, Sweden, will offer an intensive course on the *Master of Sacred Theology* level in collaboration with *Concordia Theological Seminary*, Ft Wayne, IN, USA. The course is an exploratory course with reduced fee, possible to take for non-credit. Students aiming for the S.T.M. degree can apply to include this course into a full S.T.M. degree accredited by *Concordia Theological Seminary*.

The S.T.M. degree program provides the opportunity to acquire specialized knowledge in a chosen field of theological study and to gain and use the skills necessary for scholarly work and research in theology on an advanced level.

The S.T.M. degree program is suitable both for those who wish to advance their theological knowledge and understanding beyond a Master of Divinity degree (or similar) and for those who wish to equip themselves for theological leadership in the Church.

From our Lord's mandate, through the New Testament, into the church, the Lord's Supper is His gift and our treasure. As the class studies Dr. Luther's clear confession of the Lord's Supper, it will move to critically examine modern liturgical movements that have affected the church at large. It will also "rediscover" a *Lutheran* liturgical movement from the 19th century to explore whether or not we may still learn something out of our rich Lutheran tradition.

Course fee: 3,500 SEK (a minimum of 10 students required).

Apply to the course before December 15 on our website. Requirement for admission is at least M.Div. (American system) or B.Th. (European system). Course syllabus and study plan for students applying to include the course into a full S.T.M. is found on our website.
